Traffic Offences: Refer to Regulations Manual 35 Appendix 3 Schedule R Para 6.1 (b)

- NZ Traffic laws must be strictly observed
- Incidents must be reported to Clerk of Course ASAP!

This applies to Rally Cars and Service Crews!

Damage to Property

- Any accident damage to fences, etc **must** be reported to Clerk of Course ASAP!
- Any non-reported could incur extra fees in addition to the cost of repair.

Stoppage in Stage - Non Injury:

- Emergency Safety Triangle
- Give plenty of warning (100m) on the same side of road as car!
- Display the OK Sign



- Following competitors to advise Finish Control officials of accurate position in stage, etc.
- Remember to pick up your Safety Triangle

after your car is recovered - not before!

On arrival at an accident and there is no OK sign:

Stop and Check!



If assistance is required:

- Stop a sufficient number of following competitors to provide necessary assistance-Use the SOS Sign
- Follow procedure to alert Rally HQ ASAP

If you are shown the SOS Sign: YOU MUST STOP!



- Your Assistance is required
- It is your responsibility to assist the crew you are the Medic for the car ahead of you.
- Ensure that Rally HQ are contacted URGENTLY with accurate information!

- The Emergency Number is in the Route book
- Never travel against the direction of rally traffic
- Use mobile phone if coverage available
- Nearest residence and use 0800 725 593
- Mid point Radio or End of the Stage
- Have accurate information: exact location, car number, accident details, etc.



Any and ALL impact incidents MUST be reported

- If you are stopped in a stage
- Or able to continue to stage finish
- Before Re-joining at next start control:
- Vehicle must be re-scrutineered if damaged
- Scrutineer: Mike Clements 0274 808 884
- He will sign your time card
- Crew must be checked by St John Medics at stage start

Keep the CRO informed of your intentions at all times!

Withdrawal from the Event MUST be reported to a Rally Official ASAP.

- Always exit through the stage if you can continue -<u>Never exit using side roads</u>
- If stopped in stage, have your withdrawal form completed and hand promptly to the Sweep Car.
- Advise the CRO ASAP if you wish to rejoin at the start of a Special Stage or the Lunch Regroup.
